

Corrugated mailer

ROLL-END TUCK-FRONT · ONE PIECE · TAPE-FREE

Six things separate this mailer from a plain slotted box of the same size and grade. Four of them are structural and cost nothing to specify; the other two show up after the parcel arrives, in what the customer has to do to open it and what happens to the box afterwards.

SIX REASONS TO SPECIFY IT

FORMAT



Ships flat, makes up in one motion

The blank stacks 7 mm thick, so fifty boxes travel and store in the space a handful of made-up cartons would take. At the bench it goes from flat to loaded without a former, a jig or a second pair of hands.

CLOSURE



Closes with a die-cut lock, not a consumable

The front flap tucks into a lock cut into the board. There is no tape to buy, no dispenser to keep loaded and no adhesive to fail in the cold. Tape becomes a choice about tamper evidence rather than a requirement to close.

PROTECTION



Rolled ends carry the load, not the contents

The double-thickness side walls act as corner posts, so a stack presses on the box rather than on what is inside it. The same board grade therefore rates higher here than in a plain slotted box of the same size.

RETURNS



One box, two trips

The lock reopens by hand and recloses on the same die-cut, so a return goes back in the box it arrived in. No return label pouch, no second adhesive strip and no replacement carton at the customer's end.

CERTIFICATION



Listings resolved from the record

Every mark on a CambiumPak sheet is read out of the SKU record, and a sheet covering several sizes shows only the marks all of them hold. CircleFibre 90 and ReturnReady run across the whole mailer series.

END OF LIFE



One material stream at end of life

Uncoated kraft, starch adhesive, water-based ink and no laminate, so the box goes into paper recycling whole. Nothing has to be separated out before it is put in the bin.

WHAT THE LISTINGS CERTIFY



CircleFibre 90

Post-consumer fibre content verified by mill declaration and lot sampling. The 90 is the threshold, not the score.

Held by every size



ReturnReady

Accepted whole into standard kerbside paper collection, with no liner, laminate or adhesive to separate out first.

Held by every size



ChainMark

Fibre traced through every intermediary to managed regrowth forestry, audited annually.

DropRated D3

Survives the D3 transit drop sequence — corner, edge and face — loaded to the rated gross weight.

RETURNREADY

ChainMark, DropRated D3 are held by some sizes only — see ordering

RECYCLED CONTENT

88–92% recycled by weight

Measured by weight against the finished blank, flute included. The band this figure falls into, and how it sits against the other three formats, is on the comparison sheet and not repeated here. Figures are provisional and not yet independently certified.

WARRANTY

Term	Twelve months from despatch
Covers	Material and die defects
Verified per lot	Board grade and ECT
Excludes	Crush from stacking above the rated height
