

Moulded pulp tray, twelve cavity

WET-PRESS · NESTABLE · FLANGED RIM

CP-PLP-T12 320 × 240 × 42 mm

A twelve-cavity tray is an easy thing to describe badly: twice the cavities, same everything else. The argument is narrower and better than that. This is the tray that closes, and a pack that closes on itself is a pack with one material in it, one line on the bill and one route out at the end.

SIX REASONS TO SPECIFY IT



PALLETISING

Half a pallet deck, exactly

Three hundred and twenty by two hundred and forty is half a standard deck in both directions, which means a layer of twelve-cavity trays lands square with nothing hanging over an edge. An overhanging pack is the one a forklift catches, and it is wrapped crooked and crushed at the corner before anyone opens the pallet.



CLOSURE

A rim wide enough to close on

The flange runs the full perimeter and turns the rim from something you hold the tray by into something a lid can sit on. That is the whole difference between this tray and the six: one seats twelve items, and this one seats twelve items and then shuts over them.



BILL OF MATERIALS

The lid can be another tray

Turn a second tray upside down on the first and the pack is closed, with the goods held between two sets of cavities instead of one. No board, no film, no fastener and no second line item — and the return leg is two trays nested rather than a tray plus something that has to be taken off it first.



INBOUND FREIGHT

A deeper cavity, the same nest

The cavity here is four millimetres deeper than the six's, and a hundred trays still stand about half a metre nested rather than more than four. The reason the extra depth costs nothing in transit is on the spec sheet; the effect is that a bigger tray brings in at the same rate as a smaller one.



CERTIFICATION

Listings resolved from the record

Every mark on a CambiumPak sheet is read out of the SKU record rather than placed by hand. The tray holds CircleFibre 90, SoilSafe 180 and ReturnReady, and holds all three at every size, so no sheet can show against one code a mark another code earned.



END OF LIFE

Newsprint, water, and nothing else

There is no binder, no coating, no release agent and no added colour in the tray, so what goes into kerbside paper collection is the same material that came out of it. Closed tray on tray, the whole pack goes that way as one thing, which a plastic insert under a clear lid has never managed.

WHAT THE LISTINGS CERTIFY



CircleFibre 90

Post-consumer fibre content verified by mill declaration and lot sampling. The 90 is the threshold, not the score.

SoilSafe 180

Disintegrates in commercial composting inside 180 days at 58 °C, with no screening residue above 2 mm.

Accepted whole into standard kerbside paper collection, with no liner, laminate or adhesive to separate out first.

RECYCLED CONTENT

100% recycled by weight

Measured by weight against the finished tray. The band this figure falls into, and how it sits against the other three ways of seating an item, is on the comparison sheet and not repeated here. Figures are inferred, provisional and not yet independently certified.

WARRANTY

Term	Twelve months from despatch
Covers	Forming, wall thickness, flange flatness and cavity geometry defects
Verified per lot	Wall thickness, cavity depth, flange flatness and destack force
Excludes	Trays stored damp, bruised flanges, and cavity loads above the rating
