

Paper-padded shipping envelope

FLUTED KRAFT LINER · PLASTIC-FREE · TEAR STRIP

The case for the paper-padded envelope is not that it is gentler than a bubble-lined one. It is that it is as gentle, and that it asks nothing of the person opening it — no tearing the lining out, no deciding which bin, no scissors. The protection is a tie; everything after delivery is not.

SIX REASONS TO SPECIFY IT



CUSHIONING

A paper liner that cushions like film

The fluted kraft liner absorbs a face impact as well as a 5 mm bubble film does at the same weight, which is the whole reason a padded envelope is padded. The difference is what happens afterwards: this one goes in the paper bin as it is, and the film-lined one has to be torn apart first or it goes in the bin that is not recycled at all.



COVERAGE

Lined behind the seal flap too

Most padded envelopes stop the liner at the fold, so the contents sit against a single sheet of paper for the top forty-five millimetres — which is the part of a parcel a sorter grabs. The liner here is carried on past the fold, and the coverage is continuous from seam to flap edge.



OPENING

Opens without scissors

A perforated strip runs across the top and comes away in one pull. Nothing sharp goes near the contents, which matters most for exactly the soft goods this pack is for, and the torn edge is the tamper evidence: it cannot be put back.



HANDLING

Takes a label direct

Uncoated kraft on the outer face means a shipping label presses straight onto the envelope without a carrier sheet or a documents wallet. One fewer consumable at the bench, one fewer plastic part on the parcel, and the label goes through the pulper with the paper.



CERTIFICATION

Listings resolved from the record

Every mark on a CambiumPak sheet is read out of the SKU record rather than placed by hand. The envelope holds CircleFibre 90 and ReturnReady, and holds them as inferred listings: the family is not in the published catalogue yet, and the sheet says so rather than quietly rounding up.



END OF LIFE

One material, one stream

Kraft outer, kraft liner, starch lamination, a paper peel liner and a hot-melt strip that goes through the pulper with the rest. There is nothing on this envelope to separate before it is recycled, which is the practical difference between it and the padded envelope it replaces.

WHAT THE LISTINGS CERTIFY



CircleFibre 90

Post-consumer fibre content verified by mill declaration and lot sampling. The 90 is the threshold, not the score.

ReturnReady

Accepted whole into standard kerbside paper collection, with no liner, laminate or adhesive to separate out first.

65% recycled by weight

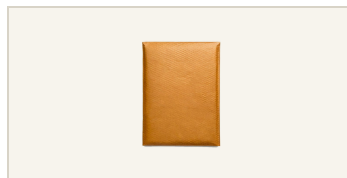
Measured by weight against the finished envelope, liner and adhesive included. The band this figure falls into, and how it sits against the other three formats, is on the comparison sheet and not repeated here. Figures are inferred, provisional and not yet independently certified.
