

Crinkle void fill

CRIMPED RECYCLED KRAFT · LOOSE FILL · NO DISPENSER

CP-VF-CR18 10 kg carton

Loose fill is usually specified on price per litre and then forgotten, which is how a bench ends up buying shredded paper and wondering why parcels arrive with the item on the floor of the box. What follows is the case for paying attention to one detail — whether the strand has a wave set into it — and what that one detail buys.

SIX REASONS TO SPECIFY IT

SPECIFICATION



It fills what is left, and nothing else

This family has one job. It goes round an item already wrapped or boxed, in the volume the carton leaves over. Specified for that it is the cheapest protection on the catalogue; specified as a cushion on a bare item it is the most expensive way to buy air.

DAMAGE RATE



Strands that hold each other up

Crimped strands bear crest on trough and hold a volume open under light compression. Uncrimped shred nests, and nested shred settles: the parcel that left with the item held off every wall arrives with it sitting on one, which is the single most common way a filled parcel fails in transit.

ELECTRONICS



Anti-static with nothing added

Cellulose at room conditions holds enough moisture not to take a charge, so this fill is anti-static because of what it is, not because of what has been sprayed on it. Nothing can migrate off it onto a board, a lens or a screen.

PRESENTATION



The one the customer is meant to see

Every other cushioning material on this catalogue does its work out of sight. This one is the first thing in the box. Undyed kraft against a kraft carton reads as a considered material rather than as packing waste.

CERTIFICATION



Listings resolved from the record

Every mark on a CambiumPak sheet is read out of the SKU record, not placed by hand. This fill holds CircleFibre 90, SoilSafe 180 and ReturnReady on its one code, and shows no mark it has not earned.

END OF LIFE



Two ways out, and both of them paper

Kerbside paper collection takes it exactly as it is, and industrial composting is the second route rather than a claim made instead of the first. Nothing is separated at the kerb, because there is nothing in the parcel that is not paper.

WHAT THE LISTINGS CERTIFY



CircleFibre 90

Post-consumer fibre content verified by mill declaration and lot sampling. The 90 is the threshold, not the score.

SoilSafe 180

Disintegrates in commercial composting inside 180 days at 58 °C, with no screening residue above 2 mm.

Accepted whole into standard kerbside paper collection, with no liner, laminate or adhesive to separate out first.

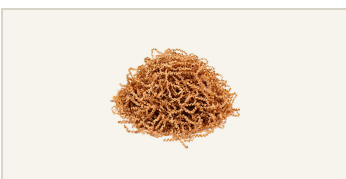
RECYCLED CONTENT

100% recycled by weight

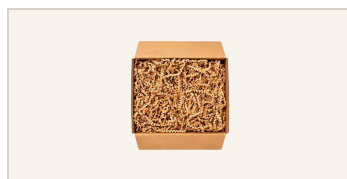
Measured by weight against the fill as supplied. The band this figure falls into, and how it sits against the other three ways of stopping movement inside a carton, is on the comparison sheet and not repeated here. Figures are inferred, provisional and not yet independently certified.

WARRANTY

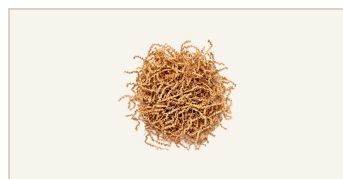
Term	Twelve months from despatch, unopened and dry
Covers	Carton weight, strand geometry, crimp retention and yield
Verified per lot	Carton weight, loosened yield, strand width and recycled content
Excludes	Cartons stored damp, fill compressed under stack, and fill returned wet from a pool
Status of figures	Inferred, provisional, not independently certified
