

Honeycomb wrap

EXPANDING DIE-CUT KRAFT · ROLL FORM · NO DISPENSER

CP-VF-HC24 600 mm × 75 m roll

The case for honeycomb is usually made at the parcel, and the parcel is the least interesting place to make it. What is on the item is a competent cushion. What is remarkable is everything upstream: a material that occupies almost nothing until the second before it is needed, and then occupies three times what it did.

SIX REASONS TO SPECIFY IT

 STORAGE It is small until the moment it is not A roll of this wrap holds enough to protect a shift's worth of parcels and takes up about as much shelf as a roll of carpet underlay. The equivalent in film arrives already blown, which means the pallet, the lorry and the shelf have all been paid for air that the item never sees.	 INBOUND FREIGHT Three times its own area, once What comes off the core is a flat web; what goes round the parcel is more than three times its area. The expansion happens at the bench in the second it is drawn, which means every mile it travelled before that was travelled flat.
 DAMAGE RATE Cells grip where a sheet slides An expanded cell has an edge standing up out of it, and those edges catch on each other and on the item. That is the practical difference between honeycomb and a crumpled sheet: a wrap that has stopped being tight is still holding, because the cells are holding each other.	 CHANGEOVER The same bench, the same motion It hangs on a bar where the film roll hung, and it is drawn, torn and folded the same way. There is nothing to install, nothing to power and nothing to retrain, which is why this is usually the first substitution a pack bench makes rather than the last.
 CERTIFICATION Listings resolved from the record Every mark on a CambiumPak sheet is read out of the SKU record, not placed by hand. This wrap holds CircleFibre 90, ReturnReady and ChainMark on its one code, and shows no mark it has not earned.	 END OF LIFE Kraft, a die cut, and nothing else There is no coating, no laminate, no adhesive and no added colour in the web, and the core is the same kraft. The whole thing goes into kerbside paper collection as one material, nothing separated first.

WHAT THE LISTINGS CERTIFY

 CircleFibre 90 Post-consumer fibre content verified by mill declaration and lot sampling. The 90 is the threshold, not the score. Held by every size	 ReturnReady Accepted whole into standard kerbside paper collection, with no liner, laminate or adhesive to separate out first. Held by every size
